22 days in Scandinavia. Depart New York Aug. 3; return Aug. 24. Cost is \$995. From New York you visit Edinburgh, Scotland; Bergen, Stalheim, Sogndal, and Oslo, Norway, taking in the incomparable beauty of the fjords by land and water; Stockholm and Gothenburg, Sweden; Aalborg, Vejle, and Copenhagen in Denmark. The scenery is breathtaking, the weather easily beats Oklahoma's, and your traveling companions will enhance a memorable journey. In addition to the special sightseeing tours, about one-fourth of your time is free. You're on your own.
