

We've got some interesting trips planned for you this summer.

The University of Oklahoma Alumni Association is offering three globe-spanning suborbital junkets for alumni and friends of the University in 1969 and is introducing two innovative, economical forays into eight countries of Europe for OU students. If the thought of letting the lawn go for three weeks this summer intrigues you, read the details of the tours below and ponder the values of such journeys. May we suggest a few: They are educational—even the dullest drone absorbs something on such journeys. They are opportunities for friendships—the congeniality of tour members is a fact. They are convenient and relatively inexpensive—traveling in a group enables one to make substantial savings and to be relieved of the time-consuming, worrisome details of accommodations, reservations, travel arrangements, tips, special tours, etc. They are restorative—people invariably return with a fresh and healthier perspective. They are fun. So do it. See our planet now before it's passé. We'll be going to the moon in a few years.

HEART OF EUROPE TOUR—Rome, Florence, Venice, Cortina, Garmisch, Munich, Lucerne, Paris, and London are the mainstays of this 22-day visit of Europe. Travel is by jet and private motor-coach. Accommodations are first rate. The dates are June 5 through June 26, and the cost is \$982.

WONDERLANDS TOUR OF SCANDINAVIA, SCOTLAND, AND LONDON—Another 22-day trip, leaving New York July 10 and returning July 31. Travel is again by jet, rail, and private motor-coach. Stopovers include Copenhagen, Stockholm, Oslo, fjord country, Balestram, Stalheim, Bergin, and Edinburgh. The cost is \$1,049.

GREEK ISLANDS AND HOLY LAND—Jackie and Ari would love to go along on this one. You visit Jerusalem, Tel Aviv, Cairo, Beirut, Athens as well as enjoy a one-week cruise on the luxury yacht Stella Oceanis with shore excursions to the magnificent islands of Greece. Twenty-two days. August 4-25. \$1,229.

STUDENT TOUR TO EUROPE—There are two 22-day tours at \$699 from New York (optional round-trip connecting flights at reduced rates are: Oklahoma City, \$120; Tulsa, \$111; Dallas, \$100). Eight countries—England, Holland, West Germany, Switzerland, Liechenstein, Austria, Italy, and France—comprise the itinerary which includes stops at London, Oxford, Stratford-on-Avon, Amsterdam, Cologne, Bonn, Koblentz, Heidelberg, Lucerne, Engleberg, Valduz, Innsbruck, Venice, Rome, Florence, Pisa, Nice, Grenoble, Fontainbleu, and Paris. The first tour departs in June, the second in July. Exact dates will be announced soon. The tours are open to OU students and college-age children of OU alumni.

Prices include transportation, first-class and deluxe hotel accommodations, meals, sightseeing, tax, tips, and other tour services.
