The Way to the Museum



Highway and street signs direct out-of-town visitors to take the Highway 9 East exit (No. 108) from Interstate 35, then turn left at the fourth stoplight (Chautauqua). Widening Chautauqua to four lanes from Highway 9 to Imhoff Road, tapering to three lanes from Imhoff to Timberdell Road, was a \$2.3 million state/federal funded project. The city of Norman enhanced the corridor with \$1.6 million in landscaping, irrigation, underground utilities, sidewalks, bike paths, and historic-style lighting.

Museum hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday. The museum is open every day except Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day.

Admission fees are \$4 adults, \$3 seniors 65 and up, \$2 children ages 6 to 17, and children 5 and under admitted free.
