"But we can lick 'em all anyway. Up and at 'em, strong sons and merry maids (er—better make that 'matrons') of the class of '13.

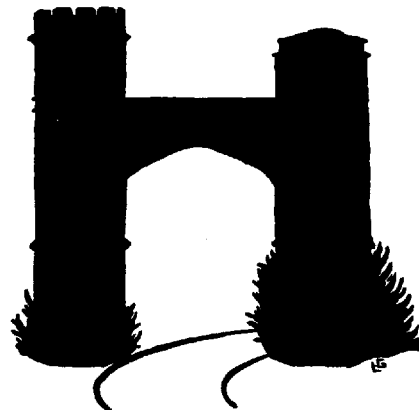
"Here's hoping for bigger and better Life Members.
