THE CLASS OF 1922 moved ahead of the class of 1910 in number of life memberships this month, and the class of '33 jumped ahead of three other classes in the standings.

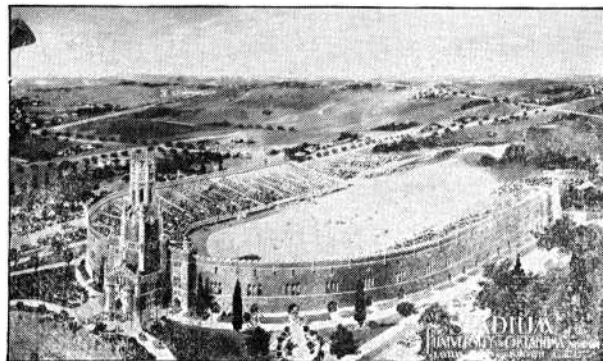
