A LIFE MEMBERSHIP costs only sixty dollars, payable either in a lump sum or five dollars a quarter. The fund is invested in high grade securities under the direction of Trustees E. R. Newby, Tom F. Carey and Neil R. Johnson. Only the income from the principal can be used for Association operating expenses.

THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION maintains a number of services and has a number of activities that are important to the University of today and to its reputation of tomorrow. As well as publishing *The Sooner Magazine*, the Association maintains a Teachers Placement Bureau for graduates, assists the University when help from its graduates is needed, encourages the organization of O.
