

"I Wonder What Time My Daddy Will Telephone?"

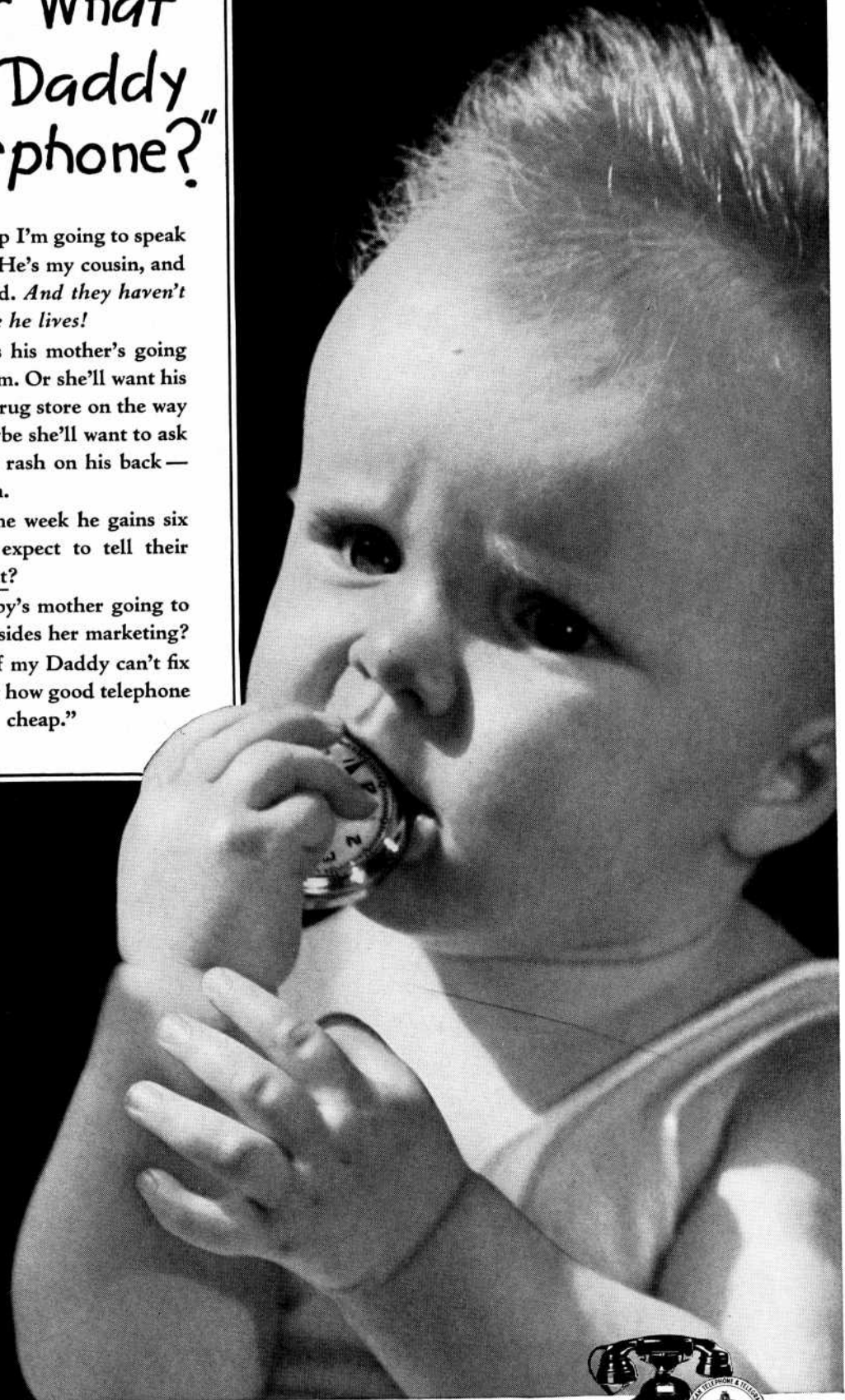
"The minute he calls up I'm going to speak to him about Bobby. He's my cousin, and he's just five weeks old. *And they haven't got a telephone where he lives!*
