Class Reunions by Mail

This information will be edited and published in the June issue of *Sooner Magazine* under your class heading for the information of other members of your class.

2 If there are other members of your class in your vicinity, see if you can arrange a small *local* reunion that will not involve much use of transportation facilities. Notify the alumni office about this meeting so that a news item can be published.

3 If there is one or more members of your class you would particularly like to have information about, write the alumni secretary and he will be glad to make an effort to get the information you want.
