**Annual Audit**

The financial position of the Alumni Association as of June 30, 1943, was somewhat improved over the previous year, according to the annual audit report made by Charles H. Allen, certified public accountant. The audit showed the cash balance on hand to be \$2,862.64, as compared to \$2,042.70 the previous year.

In accordance with the custom of recent years, the audit covered not only the receipts and expenditures of the Alumni Association, but also the financial record

of the Graduate Record and Placement Office, which is a division of the University, in order to give a complete picture of the alumni service program as supported jointly by the Association and the University.
