Here's the latest word on the progress being made on the expansion program of the Oklahoma Memorial Union.

A temporary delay encountered by architect Tom Sorey, '20ba, was explained at a special meeting of the Union Building Committee held April 1. Sorey stated that the delay was caused by the necessity of co-ordinating all work with the interior decorator in the final and detailed construction plans. Another problem which was explained by Sorey was the adaptation of the air-conditioning units to certain degree water temperatures which will be furnished by the centralized and independent refrigeration plant.

Final plans by interior decorator R. D. Harrell are nearing completion and it is believed that the Building Committee will have asked the Board of Governors to issue call for a bond sale and submit the call for construction bids before the publication of this issue of *Sooner Magazine*.
