The great quantity of gas reserves shown here include only proved and connected reserves. Other supplies of gas are known to Oklahoma Natural's geologists and will be proved by exploratory drilling and development.

**PLENTY OF NATURAL GAS IN OKLAHOMA**

Oklahoma Natural's gas reserves on hand today are over 50% greater than they were in 1940. This, despite the fact that its withdrawals have increased from year to year. In 1949 and 1950, for example, withdrawals were twice those in 1941. In spite of these withdrawals, your gas company has been able to keep well ahead of the ever increasing demand for gas by constant exploration and development activities.

So, you see, Oklahoma Natural Gas Company has plenty of gas — more than it has ever had. Moreover, it will continue its long range efforts to find more and more natural gas so your grandchildren and great-grandchildren can depend upon an even larger "savings account" of gas reserves to use for Oklahoma's ever expanding development.
