Meeting on the eve of Commencement and Class Reunions, the Executive Board of the Alumni Association elected Rhys Evans, '36ba, '39Law, Ardmore attorney, as president for 1956-57. Evans had just completed a 1-year term as vice president of the association. He succeeds Mrs. Kitty Shanklin Rountree, '23ba, Oklahoma City.
