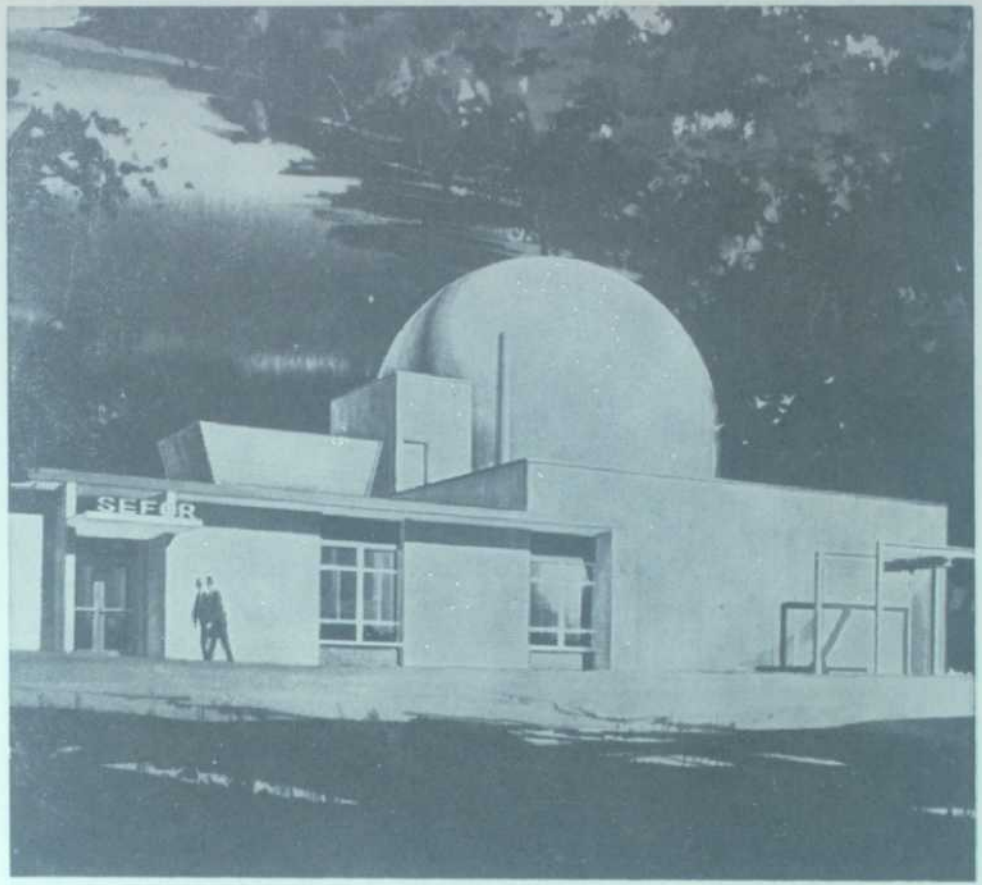
Sally Diane Smith and John Ronald Allgood, '64ba, were married August 1 in Altus. They are living in Norman.
