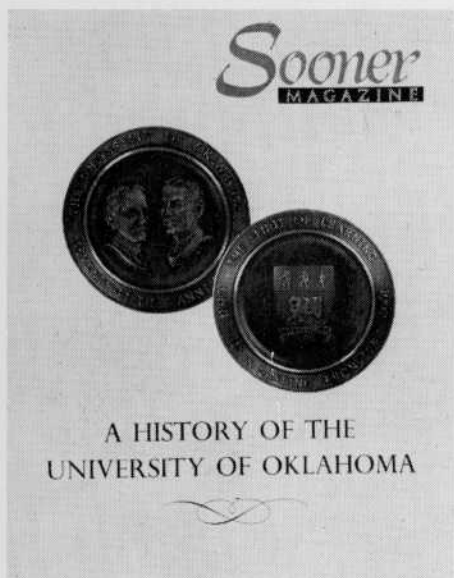


Who was the first
