Study and Scrutiny: Research on Young Adult Literature, a peer-reviewed journal, invites empirical research studies, critical/theoretical essays, and interviews with authors for its sixth issue. Edited by Crag Hill, Leilya Pitre, Steve Bickmore, Anthony Kunkel, and Terri Suico (Interview and Book Review Editor), *Study and Scrutiny* is an open access journal published twice a year by the University of Oklahoma.

For our next issue we would be particularly interested in critical articles discussing one or more of the ground-breaking novels of this body of literature: *The Outsiders*, *The Contender*, *The Chocolate War*, *A Hero Ain't Nothing But a Sandwich*, *Forever*, *The Pigman*, *Dragonwings*, and others. How do they speak of/to the era in which they were composed? How do they speak to contemporary readers? Looking back, how do they address and/or skirt over the issues of their time? Looking forward, how do they point toward the issues that confound us today? As always, we are open to empirical and critical articles on other topics. Query the editors if you have any questions.

Send submissions with a title page, 100 word abstract, and originality statement as a word file to crag.a.hill@ou.edu and cc'ed to leylja.emiraliyeva-pitre@selu.edu. Manuscripts should range from 8,000 to 12,000 words, including footnotes, references, tables and figures. All references to the author(s) should be removed from the body of the manuscript in preparation for blind review. *Study and Scrutiny: Research on Young Adult Literature* follows the sixth edition of the APA style guide.
