
An Acre of Seats in a Palace of Splendor!

FOX THEATRE - Detroit, Michigan

This magnificent theatre seats 5042, and was designed in the Byzantine style by C. Howard Crane. The Fox in St. Louis, Missouri is a twin. The huge auditorium is oval shaped and colonnaded, as the accompaning detail photo shows.

The organ is a Wurlitzer 4/36 with a slave console, and there is a smaller Moller organ on the mezzanine in the lobby.
