Trim size . . . . . 8 1/2" x 11"

Gutter Margins . . . . . 1/8"

Top & Bottom Margins . . . . . 9/16"

Outside Margins . . . . . 1/16"

**Bleed:** Add 1/8" to top, bottom and outside margins for trim. Keep reading material at least 1/4" inside the trim.
