Troubleshooting Guide Quiz Answer (Answer from page 23)

- Secondary pneumatic has a hole, causing high pressure air to leak through the secondary and down through the primary exhaust valve.
- Primary pneumatic may have been wet, so that the leather on the pneumatic (now dry) has become stiff and will not fully lift the valves.
